

Please Note:

- 1) Boys are to clean area before and after sale. Area must be kept neat. Do not use trash receptacles at location for cardboard. Bring the flattened cardboard back to the warehouse when you settle up.
- 2) Do not give boys money to purchase anything. We should not have the boys going in and out of the store at the host location. All boys should have eaten prior to coming out. Candy is not food.
- 3) During selling times you may use donation dollars to get the boys something to drink. Water or Gatorade only! Sugar drinks will just make them thirstier. Ask the Boy Scout Supervisor to assist with this.
- 4) Donation dollars may be used AFTER the boys are finished for McDonalds, Burger King, etc.. Please limit amount used to no more than \$5.00 per boy and please, no candy. (Per BSA policy—Scouts are not allowed to ask for donations.)
- 5) **THERE ARE NO TIPS!** Statements made by customers such as “Keep the change”, or, “You keep the popcorn” are considered donations. All donations are put to good use in the support of scouting.
- 6) If, when you get to your assigned location, you find another scout group selling, please do not engage them or the store manager. This happened infrequently last year and may happen again. Call Michael Beck on his cell and he will give you an alternate location. If you are approached by another scout group, you may give his number to them and he will do the same for the other group.
- 7) If a Boy Scout Supervisor has been placed with you, he is there to help you. Please stay back and give the boys some room. I am expecting the older Boy Scouts to show the new and younger boys how to merchandise, train in the presentation, and help to keep the boys moving and motivated.
- 8) Please do not use a chair or table at the location. These items take up a lot of room and work against us.
