Warren County Health Services

Warren County Health Services is an agency that continues to provide valuable programs to Warren County's 64,265 residents for over 60 years. The agency is comprised of two divisions: Homecare and Public Health, both of which are in place to serve the community in any way that is needed.

Warren County's homecare agency was the first agency of its kind in our jurisdiction, and the only homecare agency serving the needs of the entire county. The certified homecare agency provides therapy, aide, and skilled nursing services to patients in the home. Warren County's homecare professionals provide health guidance to individuals of all ages so that individuals, families, and the community can achieve and maintain health and wellness.

Warren County's homecare agency was one of the only local homecare agencies that continued in person home visits throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, checking on the most vulnerable population. Our county nurses can be easily identified driving cars with the homecare decals.

Warren County's Public Health agency focuses on population health with goals to prevent illness, promote healthy behaviors, and protect the residents in our county.

Warren County's Public Health team provides programs for all individuals, from birth, actually prenatal, to senior citizens. Programs include Health Education, Women Infant and Children Program (WIC), Maternal Child Health, Child Find, Early Intervention, Preschool Special Education Programs, Lead Prevention, Communicable Disease Control, Rabies Prevention, Clinics, Immunization, and Emergency Preparedness- including standing ready for emerging pathogens, such as West Nile, SARS, H1N1, and COVID-19 as needed.

The COVID-19 response has brought to light the vital roles and importance of public health services to our community. Warren County works with numerous community partners, such as Glens Falls Hospital and Hudson Headwaters Health Network (HHHN). We are fortunate to have many strong partners supporting our endeavors throughout the county. No matter the issue, it takes a community to work together to protect the health and safety of our people!

Warren County has dedicated staff that serves the community every day. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, our agency's goal has been to be readily available, accessible, and prepared to meet any challenges to minimize the overall impact of the pandemic. We feel we have been up to the challenge.
