

At age 8, Randy Glenn was introduced to scouting when he joined the Cub Scout Pack at Jackson Heights School in Glens Falls. Boy Scout involvement continued in the Presbyterian Church of Glens Falls Troop 3. As a Boy Scout, he enjoyed monthly outings, and summer weeks at Camp Wakpominee.
