Sunday Checkout Procedure

- (1) Pack your Troop gear and transport to vehicles or stack at campsite
- (2) Troop cleans up Deep Freeze campsite, lean-to or cabin and adjacent paths & trails
- (3) Scoutmaster (or his designee) conducts a Site Inspection
- (4) Troop corrects deficiencies

**The "Outdoor Code": Clean, Careful with Fire,
Considerate and Conservation-minded**

- _____ Fires are dead out, including charred logs
- _____ Fire rings are dismantled and fire pits are cleaned of paper, aluminum foil and garbage
- _____ Unused, scavenged firewood is returned and scattered
- _____ Split firewood (from home) to a nearby woodshed or stacked to take back home
- _____ General campsite area is free of paper, foil and garbage
- _____ Adjacent paths & trails are free of paper, foil & garbage
- _____ Trash is bagged and ready to be transported BACK HOME
- _____ All Troop and personal gear has been removed from the site (or is stacked and ready to go)
- _____ No excessive damage to Mother Nature
- _____ **Our cabin/campsite is cleaner than we found it**
