

Methods for TRC Rental of Cabins & Lean-tos for the Klondike Derby-Deep Freeze (KDDF):

1. Generally, cabins and lean-tos are rented using normal Twin Rivers Council methods on their website. This is done independently of pre-registering or registering for the KDDF.
2. Cabins go fast. SMs of troops that participate in the KDDF and need a cabin, need to find out when cabin rentals open up at TRC (first day that you can rent property/facilities in the next calendar year), and take action that first day. First come, first served.
3. This process can change year by year. Check with TRC to identify any changes.
4. KDDF leaders prefer that Boy Scout troops participating in the KDDF reserve all cabins for KDDF weekend. Cub Scout observers are discouraged from renting cabins on KDDF weekend, but we don't control this.
